**Forum objectives:** The severe global energy crisis and daily aggravating environmental problems impose paramount obstacles for the sustainable development of human beings and society. Many research efforts have been dedicated to address these issues. Ceramic materials with versatile and unique properties will offer great opportunities to face such challenges. In order to encourage and promote ceramic research for energy and environmental applications, the first China and Italy Bilateral Forum on materials science in Shanghai is to provide a unique platform for researchers from two countries to discuss these challenging issues and share their insights from various perspectives. The main aims of the forum are 1) map out the advanced research activities carried out on (ceramic) materials at selected Italian and Chinese institution, 2) promote meaningful scientific relationships between Chinese and Italian researchers working in the same field, establish long lasting scientific collaborations and exchange of students/researchers within the various institutions. Each participant will present an overview of the most significant activities carried out in his institution and discuss the plan of further interactions between participants. The Bilateral Forum will be in turn held in two countries. **The second one will be held in Italy next year.**
