

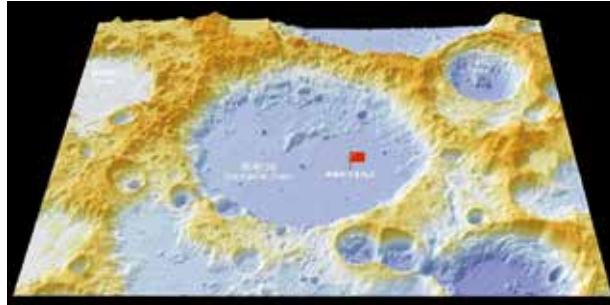

CAS Highlighted in Annual Top 10 Science Advances of China
